

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes how ForSight Robotics Ltd. ("ForSight", "we", "our", "us") process, collect, use, protect, retain and share personal information in connection with our website (the "Website").

This Privacy Policy applies to information that is identified or can reasonably be identifiable to natural persons ("Personal Information"). You are not legally obligated to provide the personal information that is specified below, however failure to provide it may impede our ability to provide certain services to you.

As part of your engagement with us and by using any of our services or when browsing the Website, we process your personal information in accordance with the Privacy Protection Law, 1981 (hereinafter: "PPL"), and any other legal provisions that apply to us.

Personal Information We Collect and how we collect it

Information you provide directly:

When you visit our Website, you may provide us with your personal information directly in the following ways:

- You can provide us with your contact information such as first and last name, e-mail address, mobile number and additional information you choose to provide if you try to contact us through our contact channel on the Website.
- You can provide us with your contact information and additional information you choose to provide when you send a request for customer support.
- You may file an application for a job opening through the Career page on the Website, providing your name, Email address, phone number, copy of your CV or link to your LinkedIn profile.
- You can provide us with your information through the Website when you ask for a demo. The information you may provide includes your name and Email address; you may also voluntarily provide your phone number, company name and job title.
- You may participate voluntarily in surveys we may conduct from time to time and provide information through the survey.

Information we collect automatically when you visit our Website:

We employ various technologies that allow us to monitor the activity and traffic on the Website for the purpose of maintaining information security, improving the efficiency of the services we provide, as well as for statistics of the Website and for improvement of our service and Website.

Such technologies include cookies, web beacons, and other storage technologies. Cookies are essentially text files (or code lines) that are created

on the browser and/or on your mobile device, to the extent that you have allowed this in the settings of the device/computer you are using, and collect relevant information, such as the duration of your visit on the site/page/screen, the browser you use, the operating system of your device and the actions performed therein. The use of cookies facilitates your identification when you revisit our websites. Additionally, the cookies will monitor your activities and automatically collect information such as: IP address, connection dates, duration of your visit, version of the operating system, type of browser, IP-based location and domain name.

Some of these technologies are provided by third parties vendors. Those third parties, such as Google, may use cookies, web beacons, and other storage technologies to collect or receive information from your websites and elsewhere on the internet and use that information to provide measurement services and targeted ads. This usage is also subject to those third parties' terms of use and privacy policies.

You can opt out from some of the cookies during your browsing, for example by adjusting the settings in your browser.

How We Use Personal Information

We use your information for:

- operating the Website and provide you with ability to use the website;
- operational purposes;
- contacting you, responding to public inquiries and customer service;
- management, streamlining and monitoring of our services in the Website and compliance with procedures and policies;
- ensuring information security;
- handling applications;
- Improvement of our services, including for statistics and research (including the use of means such as anonymization and pseudonymization, for making personal information unidentifiable or not directly identifiable);
- prevention of fraud and/or illegal activities, and protection of legal rights and legitimate interests of ours and of others, all subject to the provisions of any law.
- respond to your support requests and provide customer service.
- marketing, advertising and direct mailing purposes.
- evaluate your candidacy for a job opening if you are an applicant, including by using third-party service providers tools to manage recruitment operations.

We will not use your personal information for any other purposes without your prior consent.

How We share Personal Information

We may transfer your personal information to third parties, including to third parties overseas, in the following cases:

- For the purposes of the objectives set out in this privacy policy, for the purpose of realizing the objectives that we have been authorized to perform by law, and for the realization of legitimate interests that we have, such as the prevention of fraud. Such transfer of information will be subject to the third party's undertaking to protect the privacy and information security at a level that is appropriate for the type of information being transferred.
- As part of our engagement with subcontractors and suppliers that provide us with services (such as companies processing payments, cloud service providers, companies that provide support and maintenance for equipment, software providers, accountants, lawyers, banks, customer service centres and telecommunications companies).
- As part of a sale of the Company's business (in part or in whole) or during negotiation of such sale, provided that such third party meets the provisions of applicable laws.
- Under a court order instructing the company to do so or as required by law.
- For the purpose of defence in legal claims.
- We may transfer personal information to third parties for research and statistical purposes. In such case, personal information will be transferred in aggregate form, using measures to impede your identification with reasonable effort.

We may transfer and store your personal information outside of the country or region where you live, including in countries where the privacy laws may be considered less protective than the laws in the place where you live, for example, in the United States. If we transfer personal information outside the location where it was collected, we will ensure to have appropriate safeguards and ensure that such transfers meet applicable local legal requirements.

Advertisements and direct mailing

As mentioned above, your personal information may also be used for marketing, advertising and direct mailing purposes of ForSight, including personalized advertising.

We may send you direct mail and advertisements in relation to our services through any means of communication, including via e-mail, SMS messages, automated dialing systems and social media.

You can opt out by requesting to be removed from the mailing list of advertisements with certain means and from the mailing list of direct mail, by written application to us at the e-mail address that is specified in the mailing or through the “contact” page of the Website.

Please be advised that even after you apply for removal from the mailing list we may still be entitled to continue to send mailing that we are required and/or permitted by law to deliver to you without requiring your consent.

Links to third parties

When using the Website, links to external pages may appear, such as advertisements, banners, links etc. Should you choose to use such links, once you click on them you will be subject to the terms and the privacy protection policy of such websites/pages/applications. It is hereby clarified that you are fully responsible for the use of such outside websites/pages/applications.

Your Rights

Depending on the law where you reside, you may have certain rights under applicable privacy laws, such as accessing, correcting or deleting your personal information. You can exercise your rights by contacting us at info@forsightrobotics.com. Subject to legal considerations, we will make reasonable efforts to honor your request in accordance with applicable laws. In order to comply with your request, we may ask you for additional information to verify your identity and for security purposes.

Security

We take reasonable security measures that are appropriate to the personal information we process and in line with the standards of information security in order to protect your information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. However, please remember that no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. You are also responsible for maintaining appropriate means of information security, such as use of a strong password, anti-virus software, software updates etc.

Data Retention

We retain your information for as long as necessary for us to provide our services. In addition, we will retain your personal information for as long as we need it for resolving disputes and legal defenses, conducting audits, pursuing legitimate business purposes, enforcing agreements and in order to comply with our legal obligations. As for job candidates' applications, we will retain information on applicants who were not employed for up to one year following the end of the recruitment process.
